Maximum  
Single Credit

**Qualifying Charitable Organization**  
Contributions to a Qualifying Charitable Organization (QCO)  
You can claim either the QCO or the QFCO, or both, in the same taxable year.

**Foster Care Credit**  
Contributions to a Qualifying Foster Care Organization (QFCO)  
You can claim either the QCO or the QFCO, or both, in the same taxable year.

**Military Family Relief Credit**  
Donation to the Military Family Relief Fund  
Arizona only approves the first \$1 million in donations as credits. The fund typically fills up by early December, so be sure to mail your donation in as soon as possible.

**Public School Credit**  
Contributions Made of Fees Paid to Public Schools  
You can claim all three education credits in the same year even if you don't have a child in school

**Private School Tuition Credit**  
Contributions to Private School Tuition Organizations  
Your private school tuition donation must go to a tuition organization that provides scholarships or grants to qualified private schools.

**Certified School Tuition Credit**  
Contributions to Certified School Tuition Organizations  
To claim this credit, you must first donate the maximum amount allowed to a private school tuition organization (donations that benefit your child/dependent wont qualify)
